Pre-vocabulary: The Science of Snowflakes



Freeze - a state of weather marked by low temperature

- Crystal frozen water that has flat surfaces and sharp corners.
- **Snow -** tiny crystals of ice that fall to Earth
- **Snowflake -** clumps of ice crystals
- Hexagon snowflake a six sided symmetrical snowflake
- **Snowfall** is made up of both single ice crystals and clumps of ice crystals
- **Sleet** a mixture of rain and snow
- **Droplet -** a very small drop of a liquid, like rain
- Evaporates the process of liquid turning water into vapor
- Water vapor water in the form of gas

Precipitation - a form of water (rain, hail, sleet or snow) that falls from the sky. The form depends on the weather condition, such a temperature.
